# Rules & Regulations

This show is a regular member of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF). Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

## ENTRIES:

- **ALL HORSES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS MUST COMPLETE AN ENTRY FORM IN THE SHOW OFFICE.** Each horse must accrue a minimum of \$50.00 in entry fees or pay a \$50.00 Non-Showing fee plus stall or grounds fee. **\$35.00 OFFICE FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR EVERY HORSE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**
- **ENTRY BLANKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS SIGNED BY THE OWNER/ AUTHORIZED AGENT, TRAINER & ACCOMPANIED BY A CHECK FOR STABLING OR AN OPEN CHECK. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK.**
- **THERE WILL BE A \$50.00 LATE FEE FOR ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER OCTOBER 6TH.**
- NO CHARGE to post enter a class if done so in the horse show office the day before desired class, otherwise there will be a charge of \$10.00.
- CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE FOR ALL HORSES STABLED ON THE GROUNDS.
- THE PERSON EXECUTING THE ENTRY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETING ALL NECESSARY INFORMATION PERTAINING TO EACH ENTRY IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES OF USEF.

**HORSE REGISTRATION:** All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Registration Number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action. The Federation and/or USHJA as applicable must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. Owners are requested to notify the Federation and/or USHJA as applicable of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings.

**STALLS:** Stall rates are \$185, permanent stalls are "first-come, first-served" and require complete entry forms accompanied by barn checks. Stalls will be available on Tuesday, October 20th. Early Arrival Fee is \$10.00 extra. Stalls are permanent or tent 10' x 10' box stalls with doors. Feed, hay and shavings are to be ordered by 12 noon each day for same day delivery. Manure to be disposed of in designated areas. NO MANURE IN TRASH CONTAINERS. No stall doors or panels may be removed. A \$50.00 grounds fee charged for all horses not purchasing a stall. NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ALLOWED.

**CAMPERS:** We have camper spaces at \$175/week, please reserve your space with entry form.

**CREDIT CARDS:** We accept Master Card & Visa. The signature on the entry form authorizes Blue Ribbon Horse Shows.LLC. to charge accrued fees. There is a 3% charge for all credit card transactions.

**REFUNDS:** Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched. In either case, there will be an office processing charge of \$35.00.

**RETURNED CHECKS:** \$25.00 will be charged for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to pay with certified funds or be reported to the USEF according to GR913.

**CREDENTIALS:** ALL EXHIBITORS IN THE PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER AND ANY AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR MEASUREMENT CARD AND/OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATIONS at the show office before their numbers can be released. To speed processing send a Photostat of your card with your entry blank. All ponies or horses that do not have a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. Anyone not presenting a current USEF / USHJA membership card (or copy thereof) will be charged a Non-Member fee or if a current member, and unable to present your membership card, you may submit the appropriate affidavit & fee to these associations.

**CHANGES:** Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

**DRUGS and MEDICATIONS:** Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay \$8.00 Drug/ Medication Fee plus a \$8.00 USEF fee. USHJA Zone Fee is \$2.00.

**SCHOOLING:** There is a schooling fee of \$20 for every horse on the show grounds, showing or not. Schooling times will be posted or announced & are subject to change. **HARD HATS MUST BE WORN WHILE MOUNTED.**

**DOGS:** Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Ch. 6 & 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. Loose dogs may be impounded by Animal Control.

**ATTIRE:** It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, both open and restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when mounted anywhere on the show grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) /SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. See GR801.2. Riders must be properly attired. Protective head gear must be worn. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. See USEF GR801.10.

**FOOTING/ARENAS:** Warm Up /Competition arenas have sand footing: Ring 1=150'x275' & Ring 2=130'x225' & Ring 3=130'x200'.

**JUMP ORDER:** A rotating jumping order will be established for all classes over fences. Riders or trainers with conflicts due to having classes in both rings must see the Paddock Master so that necessary adjustments can be made. **AT NO TIME WILL EITHER RING BE HELD MORE THAN 3 MINUTES DUE TO CONFLICTS.**

**RIBBONS, TROPHIES AND CHAMPIONSHIP:** All classes receive a Trophy and 8 ribbons unless otherwise noted. Model classes will receive half points. Each Section with at least 2 over fences & 1 under saddle class will receive a Champion & Reserve award based on points earned. Hunter Champion & Reserve awarded per USEF Subchapter HU-7. Jumper Champion & Reserve to be awarded per USEFJP110.

**PRIZES:** Prize money is indicated for each class. All prize money will be mailed to exhibitors within 30 days after the show. Prize money will be withheld if Social Security number is not on file. Prize money will be payable to the owner, unless written authorization stating otherwise is on file with the show secretary. Prize money to be distributed as follows: 30% - 22% - 15% - 12% - 11% - 10% (Except as noted)

**OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Las Colinas Equestrian Center & Blue Ribbon officials against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or it's use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Las Colinas Equestrian Center & Blue Ribbon Show Management by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Las Colinas Equestrian Center & Blue Ribbon Show Management is not responsible for accidents, fire or theft.

**ANIMAL WELFARE:** We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. **In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.**

**SHARPS CONTAINERS:** Management is responsible for placing Sharps containers in convenient locations on the competition grounds and replacing them when full.

**NON-MEMBER FEES:** "Show Pass" fees will be assessed according to State & Federation regulations. USEF & USHJA Show Pass Fees are \$30 each. ANY ENTRY ONLY IN THE OPPORTUNITY SECTIONS ARE EXEMPT FROM ALL SHOW PASS FEES.

## \$5,000 Leg Up for Life USHJA National Hunter Derby

**Class 501 \$5000 USHJA Hunter Derby Entry Fee: \$375**  
In order for National Hunter Derby Zone HOTY bonus points to be awarded, riders must complete a USHJA Exhibitor Declaration Form. Management will require that a same horse/rider combination must have entered and shown in at least 2 classes during the same competition. All riders in the Top 8 overall must ride for ribbons in order to receive prize money. **Minimum of 12 entries.** Riders, owners, and trainers must be current active member of USEF and USHJA before the start of the class. (see GR202). Horses and ponies competing in this class must be registered with USHJA prior to the start of the class and to be eligible for Zone HOTY bonus points must have an active USEF recording. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. In each round, after the judges' base score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped without major fault (i.e. refusal, knockdown), up to a maximum of four. During the two phases of the National Hunter Derby, all horses entered must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas unless Management designates a specific schooling area for National Hunter Derby horses. Riders must wear their horse's Derby competition number while mounted. This includes horses entered simultaneously in another class, if any. Entered horses ridden or schooled elsewhere on the competition grounds or NOT wearing their Derby competition number will be eliminated from competing in the Derby and the entry fee will be forfeited.

### First Round: Classic Hunter Course

A minimum of ten obstacles must be offered in the Classic Hunter Round. Fence height 3'0". There must be four option fences set at 3'5". At least one In and Out. At least one Bending Line. At least one line with an unrelated distance. At least one long approach.

### Second Round: Handy Hunter Course

A minimum of eight obstacles must be offered in the Handy Hunter Round. Fence height 3'0". There must be four option fences set at 3'5". The course should simulate riding over hunt country and must have a minimum of two handy options, such as: tight turns, different tracks, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle not to exceed 2'6" in height, halt and/or back. Only the top twelve (12) horses from First Round, after all ties are broken, are eligible to return for Second Round.
