Rules & Regulations

This show is a regular member of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF). Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

ENTRIES: NO CHARGE to post enter a class if done so in the horse show office the day before desired class, otherwise there will be a charge of \$10.00. **ENTRY BLANKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS SIGNED BY THE OWNER/ AUTHORIZED AGENT, TRAINER & ACCOMPANIED BY A CHECK FOR STABLING OR AN OPEN CHECK. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK. THERE WILL BE A \$35.00 LATE FEE FOR ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER OCTOBER 12TH.** CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE FOR ALL HORSES STABLED ON THE GROUNDS. THE PERSON EXECUTING THE ENTRY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETING ALL NECESSARY INFORMATION PERTAINING TO EACH ENTRY IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES OF USEF. \$35.00 office fee will be charged for every horse on the show grounds.

STALLS: Entries postmarked by October 12th stalls are \$160.00, after October 12th stalls are \$185.00. Stalls will be available on Tuesday, October 25th. Early Arrival Fee is \$10.00 extra. Stalls are permanent 10' x 10' box stalls with doors. Feed, hay and shavings are to be ordered by 12 noon each day for same day delivery. Manure to be disposed of in designated areas. NO MANURE IN TRASH CONTAINERS. No stall doors or panels may be removed. **NOTE:** A \$50.00 non-showing fee for horses not competing in classes. A \$40.00 grounds fee charged for all horses not purchasing a stall. NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ALLOWED.

CAMPERS: We have camper spaces at \$175/weekly and please reserve your space with your entry form.

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched. In either case, there will be an office processing charge of \$35.00.

RETURNED CHECKS: \$25.00 will be charged for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to pay with certified funds or be reported to the USEF according to GR913.

CREDENTIALS: ALL EXHIBITORS IN THE PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER AND ANY AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR MEASUREMENT CARD AND/OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATIONS at the show office before their numbers can be released. To speed processing send a Photostat of your card with your entry blank. All ponies or horses that do not have a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. Any-one not presenting a current USEF / THJA membership card (or copy thereof) will be charged a Non-Member fee or if a current member, and unable to present your membership card, you may submit the appropriate affidavit & fee to these associations.

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

DRUGS and MEDICATIONS: Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay \$8.00 Drug/ Medication Fee plus a \$7.00 USEF fee.

SCHOOLING: There is a schooling fee of \$20 for every horse on the show grounds, showing or not. Schooling times will be posted or announced & are subject to change. **HARD HATS MUST BE WORN WHILE MOUNTED.**

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Ch. 6 & 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. Loose dogs may be impounded by Animal Control.

ATTIRE: It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, both open and restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when mounted anywhere on the show grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) /SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. See GR801.2. Riders must be properly attired. Protective head gear must be worn. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. See USEF GR801.9.

HORSE REGISTRATION: All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Registration Number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action. The Federation and/or USHJA as applicable must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. Owners are requested to notify the Federation and/or USHJA as applicable of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings.

FOOTING/ARENAS: Warm Up /Competition arenas have sand footing: Ring 1=150'x275' & Ring 2=130'x225' & Ring 3=130'x200'.

HUNTER SPECIFICATIONS: Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in & out, oxer, post/rails, gates, aiken, and panels. In some classes the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring. Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted in the prize list. **Sections WITH LESS THAN FOUR ENTRIES will be combined & any combined section with less than four entries may be canceled. HU161.**

JUMP ORDER: A rotating jumping order will be established for all classes over fences. Riders or trainers with conflicts due to having classes in both rings must see the Paddock Master so that necessary adjustments can be made. **AT NO TIME WILL EITHER RING BE HELD MORE THAN 3 MINUTES DUE TO CONFLICTS.**

RIBBONS, TROPHIES AND CHAMPIONSHIP: All classes receive a Trophy and 8 ribbons unless otherwise noted. Model classes will receive half points. Each Section with at least 2 over fences & 1 under saddle class will receive a Champion & Reserve award based on points earned. Hunter Champion & Reserve awarded per USEF Subchapter HU-7. Jumper Champion & Reserve to be awarded per USEFJP110.

PRIZES: Prize money is indicated for each class. All prize money will be mailed to exhibitors within 30 days after the show. Prize money will be withheld if Social Security number is not on file. Prize money will be payable to the owner, unless written authorization stating otherwise is on file with the show secretary. Prize money to be distributed as follows: 30% - 22% - 15% - 12% - 11% - 10% (Except as noted)

OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Las Colinas Equestrian Center & Blue Ribbon officials against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or it's use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Las Colinas Equestrian Center & Blue Ribbon Show Management by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Las Colinas Equestrian Center & Blue Ribbon Show Management is not responsible for accidents, fire or theft.

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. **In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.**

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Management is responsible for placing Sharps containers in convenient locations on the competition grounds and replacing them when full.

NON-MEMBER FEES: Non-Member fees will be assessed according to State & Federation regulations. THJA Non-Member fee is \$10, USEF & USHJA Non-Member Fees are \$30 each.

Adult Amateur Hunter: To be ridden by Amateurs no longer eligible to compete as Junior exhibitors. Open to horses and ponies. State rules may prohibit entry of ponies (see exception paragraph below). Cross Entry: The same rider/horse (pony) combination may not compete at the same show in any class (equitation and USHJA National Hunter Classic excepted) in which fence heights exceed 3'3". The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same show in any other division or section for which the rider/mount are eligible. Children's Hunter: To be ridden, and handled in all phases of competition, by Junior exhibitors. Open to horses and ponies. State rules may prohibit entry of ponies (see exception paragraph below). Cross Entry: The same rider/horse (pony) combination may not compete at the same show in any class (equitation and USHJA National Hunter Classic excepted) in which fence heights exceed 3'3". The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same show in any other division or section for which the rider/mount are eligible. The horse or pony may be shown by a different rider in any other division or section at the same show except Junior Hunter or a different age group in Children's Hunter. Exception: A state association may adopt more (but not less) restrictive cross entry rules (see below). Course and Judging Specifications: Fence height: 3', spread not to exceed fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability of mount to rider. Entries are not required to jog for soundness.

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Classic: Any competition which offers an Adult Amateur Hunter or a Children's Hunter section may also offer an Adult Amateur Classic and/or a Children's Hunter Classic in accordance with HU146. All current Zone 7 eligibility requirements must be met.

Children's Hunter Pony: Open to ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor with no other age restrictions applicable. Rider and/or pony may enter any Equitation classes. The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same show in any other division or section where the jumps do not exceed 3'. The pony may be shown by a different rider in any other division or section at the same show except USEF Rated Hunter Pony classes. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, suitability of size of rider to mount, and suitability as a Children's Hunter. Ponies not required to be jogged for soundness. Small ponies to be shown at 2', Medium Ponies at 2'3", and Large Ponies at 2'6"; spreads not to exceed height of fence. No minimum prize money is required.

Pre-Green Hunter: A Pre-Green hunter is a horse in his 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 3' or higher at Regular Member Competitions or Combined Training Events. A horse may show in the Pre-Green Hunter Section of an USEF Zone 7 Recognized Competition for no more than two years. Pre-Green Classics will be awarded points equal to those given in USEF "B" Hunter Classics. Show management may offer two sections of Pre-Green Hunter (Fence Heights 3' and 3'3") or only one section at either height. Horses may only be entered in one section. Horses showing in Pre-Green may not show in any 3'6" or over classes at the same show. Zone awards will be presented annually as one section. 


